Unfortunately, there has been some extremely incorrect information circulating in the community pertaining to the Custer Chamber of Commerce and the cancellation of the Tesla Rally, which was held in May for the past several years. After years of issues arising from, and during this event with little return to the chamber and the community of Custer, coupled with the event contact person stepping away after the 2024 rally, the chamber board of directors voted at the July 2024 board meeting to discontinue this event. That information was scheduled to be published at that time, but an oversight occurred, and it did not make it to the public. Our meeting minutes will in fact reflect that decision that was made last July. The 2025 Chamber Event calendar was published in the fall of 2024, and that event was in fact not included as a chamber happening for the upcoming year.

A rumor has arisen suggesting that the Chamber canceled this event due to political protests related to Elon Musk. This claim is false. The Custer Chamber of Commerce, including its board, directors, and staff, is committed to keeping political opinions out of our decisions regarding community events. Our primary focus is on supporting our members and the community as a whole, and we take pride in doing so.

Project Update

Friday, April 4, 2025

Current Construction:

- Phase 2 construction operations currently involve off-road grading, tree clearing, logging operations, and controlled rock blasting. The contractor is using a pilot car and flaggers as needed from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. (MT) on weekdays and some Saturdays.
- The speed limit in the Phase 2 construction area has been reduced to 45 miles per hour.
 Upcoming Construction:
- On Monday, April 7, 2025, the contractor will begin milling (removal of the existing pavement) on U.S. Highway 385 from one-half mile south of Sheridan Lake Road to Calumet Road and from the south end of Pactola Dam to just north of McCurdy Gulch Road. Motorists can expect flaggers and pilot cars throughout the Phase 2 construction area, large machinery, narrowed driving lanes, increased noise and dust, and a loose gravel surface.

- Saturday, April 19, 2025.
- Closure D (Be Still Road to Calumet Road) takes effect on Monday, April 28, 2025, and ends Friday, June 13, 2025. During this time period, the closed roadway will not be open to through traffic. Outside of the closure, but within the construction area, travelers can expect pilot cars and wait times, the use of large construction equipment, narrowed driving lanes, and loose gravel surfacing.
- Phase 1 (Pactola Dam to the Pennington-Lawrence County Line) permanent surfacing takes place this summer and will be completed by the end of July 2025. Currently, there are approximately two miles of gravel and three miles of hard surface between Pactola Dam and the Pennington-Lawrence County Line. During this time period, roadway users can expect the use of flaggers and pilot cars with delays up to 15 minutes.
- Closure C (Sheridan Lake Road to Be Still Road) begins on Tuesday, Aug. 12, 2025, and ends on Friday, Oct. 17, 2025. Closure E (Pactola Dam to Taylor Ranch Road) begins on Monday, Oct. 20, 2025, and ends on Friday, March 6, 2026.

About the Project

The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT) is reconstructing a portion of U.S. Highway 385 between the Pennington-Lawrence County Line and the south end of Sheridan Lake. Once completed, this section of Highway 385 will feature safety improvements, including wider shoulders on each side of the road where possible, improved road curves to meet current design standards, additional turning lanes to improve traffic flow, and new surfacing. Learn more about this project by watching *this presentation*. Phase 2 is currently under construction.






