150th Anniversary Commemoration 1874 Custer Expedition and Start of the Black Hills Gold Rush



In 1874 the Custer Expedition explored the Black Hills and found gold along French Creek, igniting the Black Hills Gold Rush. Recognizing the importance of these events and changes they brought, the Custer County Historical Society and the Case Library for Western Historical Studies are sponsoring a 150th Anniversary Commemoration on Sunday, July 21, 2024 (during Gold Discovery Days) at the historic 1874 camp site three miles east of Custer, SD. This free event will feature presentations, demonstrations and self-guided tours. American Center Road in Custer State Park Temporarily Closed

PIERRE S.D. – The South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks (GFP) announced beginning Friday, April 5, American Center Road will be completely closed from the junction of Hwy 87 (Needles Highway) to the eastern border of the park.

"Due to current adverse road conditions, which would be characterized by significant sloppiness and numerous frost heaves, we want to ensure public safety by closing the road," said Lydia Austin, Visitor Services Supervisor. "The extended forecast predicts additional moisture, which would lead to further exacerbating the road's condition."

GFP expects to reopen American Center Road to traffic by May 1, 2024, following necessary repairs and improvements.

During this closure, Center Lake and the Black Hills Playhouse will remain operational and accessible to the public via Highway 87 (Needles Highway).

Project Update

Friday, April 5, 2024

Current Conditions:

- Users of the roadway can expect delays of 15 minutes and the use of pilot cars and flaggers.
- Traffic is being diverted on a gravel diversion (a temporary at-grade roadway next to the original road) approximately 3/4-mile north of the intersection of U.S. Highway 385 and S.D. Highway 44. A width restriction of 12 feet is in place.
- The contractor is installing a box culvert approximately 3/4-mile north of the intersection of Highway 385 and Highway 44. This box culvert will direct water under the roadway to reduce erosion during storm events.
- Construction on a second diversion is underway. This diversion is located immediately south of the Pennington-Lawrence County Line.

Coming Up:

- Traffic is being kept on existing pavement or as long as possible as construction progresses.
- Traffic is expected to be diverted on to a second diversion, located immediately south of the Pennington-Lawrence County Line, in mid-April. A press release and text message alert will be distributed to share further details

- distributed to share further details.
- The contractor is preparing to pour the floor of the box culvert near Highway 44.
- Temporary fence installation will begin later this spring in the project area.
- Rock blasting may occur within the project area in the next month. If rock blasting occurs, the
 roadway will have signage and text alerts will be sent. Rock blasting could result in 1-2 hours of
 delay for roadway users and is expected to take place in early afternoons on weekdays.


