



- Iron Mountain Road will be closed for the majority of the day

- Tuesday, Oct. 8:

- Hood Tunnel on Needles Highway (flaggers will guide traffic, minor delays expected)
- Needles Eye Tunnel and Iron Creek Tunnel on Needles Highway (section closed for the majority of the day)

- Wednesday, Oct. 9:

- Miner's Gateway Tunnel in Keystone (traffic diversion on Highway 16A, no delays expected)

- Thursday, Oct. 10:

- Makeup day for inspections delayed due to weather or other circumstances

- Iron Mountain Road: Closed on Monday
- Needles Highway: Section closed on Tuesday, minor delays at Hood Tunnel

Every day, young adults leave the nest and embark on journeys into adulthood, leaving behind parents crossing their fingers and hoping for the best, while expecting panicked calls home for advice or assistance.
